Lake Constance

Lake Constance seems to be a central organ of the landscape of Europe and of the earth. Extensive landscapes are connected with it in mutual exchange. She invites us humans to be with her at the time of the summer solstice in 2018 to work with her. The focus of the meeting is the current transformation of the earth and humanity. Previous meditations have shown that Lake Constance is also undergoing a profound process of change. We are curious about what will continue to show itself and be incorporated into the LifeNet meeting .

Bring together, connect, transform

The LifeNet meeting will be held in three steps:

- At home, each participant will visit the place where they have a heart connection and explore and record its qualities. This may be done individually or in a group.
- Like bees, we humans will bring the qualities we collected as nectar to the LifeNet meeting. During the meeting, we will connect the qualities of the different places and people on Lake Constance and explore what kind of honey will come out of it.
- Everyone will take home the honey with its new qualities and fertilise their place of the heart with it.
